



Town Hall Meeting

To Support Workers At Fuyao Glass Organizing With the UAW

Fuyao Glass in Moraine, OH, has become the largest automotive glass plant in the world. Located in a former General Motors plant, Fuyao now employs at least 1,500 workers, and plans to grow to 2,500 workers or more within a year. Fuyao workers start at just \$12.84/hour, far less than workers at UAW-represented glass plants. The company's low pay, high turnover, and unsafe working conditions pose a direct threat to UAW members at glass plants in Region 2B. The company has received \$22 million in public subsidies to open and grow the plant.

Fuyao workers have been fighting hard to form their union with the UAW. **Region 2B Director Ken Lortz has made supporting these workers a top priority.** On Sunday, April 30th, we need UAW members to **turn out big** to support these workers. The Town Hall meeting will give Fuyao workers a chance to shed light on what it's like to work in this extremely difficult and dangerous plant. Local elected officials, including Montgomery County Commissioner Deborah A. Lieberman and County Clerk of Courts Greg Brush, will be there to show support for Fuyao workers fighting to form their union.
