**Layoff Informational Meeting:** On Tuesday, January 21, 2020 and Monday, January 27 we will be holding informational meetings for members who are affected by the upcoming layoff at 9:00 am at the Union Hall. We will have representatives available from Ohio Means Jobs and Ohio Department of Job and Family Services. Clark State Community College has also been invited to talk about funding for training that may be available as well. During the meetings they will discuss employment opportunities, unemployment benefits, benefit procedures and any other services available to those laid off. They will be available to answer any questions regarding filing claims and any other unemployment questions. Our insurance and benefits representative will also be available to answer questions.

**Election Committee Nominations and Election:** Nominations and Election for the UAW Local 402 Election Committee (eleven members) will be held at 4pm, Wednesday, February 12, 2020 at the UAW Local 402 Union Hall. Election Committee members will serve a two (2) year term and be responsible for conducting Local 402's election of officers, bargaining committees, convention delegates and Labor Contract strike and ratification votes. All UAW Local 402 members in good standing are eligible to run for the Election Committee. Members running for a position need to either be present at the meeting or have a letter of acceptance of nomination submitted to the Recording Secretary at the Union Hall prior to 4pm, February 12, 2020. Nomination and Election will take place during the monthly membership meeting. In the event of mandatory overtime, the meeting will start at 4:45 pm.

**John Minchin Scholarship:** Friday, February 21, 2020 is the application deadline for the UAW Local 402 John Minchin Scholarship. This year we will award 12 \$500.00 scholarships. This scholarship is available for all students who will be enrolled in college this fall whose parents or grandparents are active, laid off and retired members of UAW Local 402.
