

Triennial Election Notice

On May 20th, 2020 U.A.W. Local 402 will hold Triennial Elections for Executive Board Officers, Bargaining Chairman, Bargaining Committeemen, and State Workers Compensation Representative. All of the above offices are for a three year term. (In the event of a runoff, runoff election will be May 27th.)

If you are on: inactive/medical/layoff status or retired you will vote at the union hall.**

Ballot Information

For the May 20th 2020 election paper ballots will be used. The order in which the candidates' names appear on the ballots are determined by a lottery drawing on April 17th at 3:45pm.

When entering the voting locations you will be asked by the election committee for identification (ex. Gate Pass, 402 member card, driver's license, Social Security card, etc.). You will then register on the election roster by providing your name, clock number, department, and shift.

Candidates' may have one election observer each to check the ballot boxes prior to the start of election at the union hall. They must be at the union hall at 5am. They may also observe the voting process at the polls and the vote count at the union hall at 4pm/5pm if O.T. is worked. All observers must be designated in writing and verified by the Election Chairperson Cindy Knotts prior to the election.

Per the UAW Constitution Article 38 Section 2 (5) Majority Vote for Trustees:

Where Local Unions are electing three (3) trustees for three-year terms, the following shall apply:

- 1) Trustees are elected simultaneously and there is no distinction between the offices and the membership is entitled to vote for three (3) trustees.
- 2) Where there are less than seven (7) candidates, the three (3) candidates receiving the greatest number of votes shall be declared elected.

Election Results will be posted immediately after the Election Committee finalizes the vote tally the evening of May 20th.
