**Recall/Layoff:** The company sent out 6 more recall letters this week. The last member sent a recall letter in production was clock #28217, A. Roberts, seniority date 10/8/2018. We still have 110 members on indefinite layoff.

**Zone 1 Committeeman Nominations/Election:** On December 16, 2020 we will be holding an election for the remainder of the term for Zone 1 Committeeman expiring June of 2023. Only active members in the following departments are eligible to vote in this election: Line 1/Vista 1 53, 54, 55, 65 69, 71, 72, 73, 86, 92 and 64. Line 1 Vista II: 852 column #32 south, 854, 855, 865, 872, 892 and 864 1<sup>st</sup> shift. Voting polls will be open from 5:30 am through 4:00 pm at the following locations: assembly plant gates A, B, C & D. If you are on PA/Vacation or medical/short-term disability status, you will vote at the Union Hall. Per UAW Constitution, members on indefinite layoff are not eligible to vote in this election. Please have your gate pass or driver's license ready when entering the voting location. Please follow all safety guidelines, wear your mask and maintain at least 6 feet social distance when possible.
