- The Company announced that they will cease operations in Melrose Park by November 2021. This will affect over two hundred of our UAW Brothers and Sister that are covered under our Main Labor Contract. The Company stated that approximately half of the employees will be relocating to Lisle or other Navistar facilities.
- The Union is waiting on the Company's response from the 2 ¼ step grievance meeting held on January 8, 2021. We are still waiting on the Company to schedule a 2 ½ step grievance meeting.
- We have not received any updates pertaining to the purchase of Navistar by VW's TRATON.
- May 1st and June 5th are two of the four Saturdays that the Company cannot schedule mandatory overtime. When the company notifies us of the other two, we will inform the Membership.
- The Company is in the process of paying out the holiday pay due to Covid related absences on the qualifying days per the memorandum of understanding that was reached on November 1, 2020 between the Local Union and the Company. They have already paid out July 4th, Labor Day, Veterans Day, and are currently working on the Thanksgiving Holiday pay.
