Line 2 Production Update: Line 2 production remains temporarily suspended due to part shortages. As of now there is no update as to when production will resume. Please continue to call the Navistar Production Status Update Line at 937-390-2900 on Fridays after 3:30 pm as previously instructed for updates.

Line 1 Production: Line 1 production is still scheduled to increase to 115 units per day beginning July 19, 2021. I would like to welcome everyone from SAP and our TSC units back from indefinite layoff. We no longer have any Local 402 members on indefinite layoff status. The company is still in the process of interviewing and hiring 200 plus employees for the production increase. If you know anyone who would be interested in applying the website is Navistar.com.

Corporate Visit: A few weeks ago President of Navistar Truck & Engine, Phil Christman, visited the Springfield Assembly Plant. Before his tour he took the time to meet with SAP's plant manager, our Bargaining Chairman Shawn Reed, and myself. During our discussion we addressed our concerns about the future of Springfield with the addition of the San Antonio plant. He assured us that there is a future in Springfield based on Navistar wanting to retain and gain market shares and that the company would need both plants to do so. He also mentioned the importance of attendance to ensure the quality of our trucks. We all have a responsibility to our current and future customers to come to work every day and to continue to build the best quality truck to secure our future here in Springfield. Thank you all for your hard work and dedication day in and day out. Navistar and GM are currently having discussions on extending their agreement on Line 2. Navistar and GM have an agreement on Line 1 through 2027.

COVID/Mask Update: We are waiting for corporate to compile the CDC's guidelines and all of the state's requirements to determine a corporate wide decision for mask requirements. Currently, the mask requirement for our plant is still in effect and will be enforced.

Union Meeting Update: All UAW Local 402 membership meetings and events will resume after the July shutdown. We will post all meeting and event dates and times when we return from shutdown.

Union Hall/Park Rentals: We will begin taking reservations for the 402 Recreation Park beginning Monday, May 24th at 7:30 am. We will not be renting the Union Hall for the remainder of this year.
